

Wiley 1L & 2L Scholarship Opportunities

Wiley is pleased to offer scholarships up to \$25,000 to talented 1L and 2L students who have demonstrated financial need and academic, leadership, and/or professional accomplishments while weathering adversity. We strive to promote an inclusive workplace where everyone is engaged.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship recipients are eligible to receive up to \$25,000 in scholarship assistance. Scholarship payments will be made as follows:

- \$10,000 is awarded at the beginning of the firm's summer associate program.
- \$5,000 is contingent upon receiving and accepting an offer as a 2L Summer Associate at Wiley.
- \$10,000 or \$15,000 is contingent upon receiving and accepting an offer as a full-time associate at Wiley.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for Wiley's scholarships will be evaluated across several factors:

- Applicants must attend an ABA-accredited law school.
- Applicants cannot receive the scholarship without also receiving a 1L or 2L position in the firm's summer program.
- Recipients must commit to all 10 weeks of Wiley's summer program.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need and academic, leadership, and/or professional accomplishments while weathering adversity.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for a 1L or 2L Scholarship, applicants must follow the steps below.

- Submit an application for a 1L or 2L position in Wiley's summer associate program.
- Select "Yes" on your application to indicate that you would like to be considered for a scholarship.
- Upload a brief personal statement (500 words or less) describing how you satisfy the eligibility criteria.
